

**THE NALITABARI PUBLIC GAMBLING
REGULATION, 1951**

East Bengal Regulation No. IV of 1952

[29th July, 1952]

*A Regulation to apply the ¹[***] Public Gambling Act, 1867, to the Nalitabari Police Station in the district of Mymensingh.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to apply the ¹[***] Public Gambling Act, 1867, to the Nalitabari Police Station, in the district of Mymensingh;

AND WHEREAS by sub-section (2) of section 92 of the Government of India Act, 1935, the ²[Government] is empowered to make regulation for the peace and good Government of any area in which is for the time being an excluded area, or a partially excluded area.

NOW, THEREFORE, the ³[Government] in exercise of the said powers and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, is pleased to make the following Regulation:-

Short title and commencement

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Nalitabari Public Gambling Regulation, 1951.

(2) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Official Gazette*.

Application of ¹[***] Act II of 1867 to the Nalitabari Police Station in the district of Mymensingh

2. The ¹[***] Public Gambling Act, 1867, shall apply to the Nalitabari Police Station, in the district of Mymensingh.
