

THE APPROPRIATION (SUPPLEMENTARY) ACT, 1974

ACT NO. XLII OF 1974

[28th June, 1974]

An Act to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund for the services of the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1974.

WHEREAS it is expedient to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund for the services of the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1974;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (Supplementary) Act, 1974. Short title
2. There may be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Taka two hundred seventy-eight crores, ninety-one lakhs and ninety-six thousand towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1974, in respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
